Stages of Learning

Embedded instruction can be used to support children in all stages of learning. Identifying a child's stage of learning is an important part of planning, implementing, and evaluating embedded instruction.

Learning

- ✓ Acquisition—Learning a new skill
- ✓ Fluency—Gaining the ability to perform a skill in a continuous or fluid way

Mastery

- ✓ Generalization—Using learned skills or behaviors across different settings, people, times, activities, or materials
- ✓ Maintenance—Using the same skill over time
- ✓ Adaptation—Using elements of previously learned skills that can be adapted to new demands and situations
